Payroll | Auris Hire verifies that your job applicants are eligible to work in the U.S.

Auris Hire confirms your applicants comply with immigration law and are authorized to work in the U.S. E-Verify compares an employee's Form I-9 employment eligibility verification to data from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and Social Security Administration records to confirm employment eligibility.

How does E-Verify work?

An employer enters an employee's information from Form I-9 to E-Verify to create a case. E-Verify compares the information to records available to the U.S. Department of Homeland security including:

- U.S. passport and visa information.
- State-issued driver's license and identity document information.
- Social Security Administration records.
- Immigration and naturalization records.

If the information matches, the case will receive an "Employment Authorized" result almost immediately. If the information does not match, the case will receive a "Tentative Nonconfirmation" result.

E-Verify in three easy steps with Auris Hire
